Ideal for IEP meetings, parent-teacher conferences and other education-focused meetings, Video Chats are automatically recorded and stored on the Student Card alongside student data and parent communication records for compliance and review. It provides a platform for groups to communicate in real time without the hassles of gathering everyone in the same location—scheduling time off work, securing child care, arranging transportation—that can get in the way of the meeting itself.

Accomplish more when you pair the ease of a conference call with the added ability to share files, show your screen, text chat and have a recording for reference and compliance.

Follow the conversation and understand who said what with the help of video.
